- The Lord will cause my enemies who rise up against me to be defeated before my face. They may come out against me one way, but they flee before me seven ways.
- The Lord commands the blessing on me in my storehouse, in my bank accounts, and in all that I undertake. Everything I touch turns to gold. He blesses me in the land which He gives me.
- The Lord establishes me as a person holy to himself, for I keep the commandments of the Lord my God, and I walk in His ways.
- All people on earth shall see that I am called by the name of the Lord, and they shall be afraid of me.
- The Lord my God grants me plenty of goods through my work, my investments, my business, and my land, all of which He gave me.
